Due to the demand of the Summer School, please book places as early as possible as accommodation is very limited in Maynooth College. On-campus accommodation is limited to Saint Patrick's House and the College Apartments on the North Campus. As the standard of accommodation in the North Campus apartments is superior to that of St Mary's, we would encourage participants who would not mind the short walk to book them. They provide a kitchen and common area with bathroom and shower facilities. In order to secure a room in either building at the early rate, booking forms must be sent with a non-returnable deposit of €50 and full payment to be made before **Monday 1st June, 2009**.
